

“Double Play”

1. What is it?

When a team has a missing team member(s) and only can play 2 or less, teams can play ONE player TWICE instead of forfeiting the 3rd match. Double Play will be used when a team is short a player(s). Unless, of course the team short the player(s) refuses to play someone twice. (full fees must be paid in both situations)

This benefit is **limited to 4 times per session** and not eligible to be used during the last 2 team Matches of play. If you think your team will have trouble fielding players, you can always pre-play your match.

2. How to utilize this:

The **OPPOSING** team (with full roster attending) will choose which player will play twice.

****If in the event you are planning to use the “Double Play” rule and you have a player that needs to leave, you must inform the opposing team captain and ask them if they planned on using that player. If the opposing team captain is not informed, you run the risk of the ‘full’ team choosing that player who left, which in turn, would be a forfeit.****

Payment: Payment for the member who plays twice is up to the team. The forfeit would have had to be paid for. Decide ahead of time whether it is the players’ responsibility or if the team will divide it equally.
