To help make your day of League play enjoyable, as well as enhance the enjoyment of those around you, please observe basic guidelines of etiquette. Treat your opponent as you would like to be treated. Pay attention to your match; be ready to shoot when it is your turn so you don't slow down the match. If you are expected to play the next match, have your cue ready, and begin your match as soon as the previous match is over. Cheering for your teammate is part of the fun, but don't cheer **against** your opponent. A fun and competitive day of League play is a goal that can be achieved by observing these guidelines and displaying good sportsmanship.
